- Admissions policy and information on school website



#### **Timeline**

BEAL

- Application process opened on Monday 1st September 2025 for children whose birthday falls between 1st September 2014 and 31st August 2015
- You must apply through the Redbridge eAdmissions portal and attach necessary documentation
- The application process closes <u>before</u> Midnight, at 23:59 on Friday 31<sup>st</sup> October 2026
- Parents will be notified of the outcome on Monday 2nd March
   2026
- The deadline for parents to **accept the offer** of a place is **15th March 2026.** Log into your eAdmissions account to do this
- LBR have a published **appeals** process
- If you are offered your FIRST preference school, the lower preference schools are **automatically withdrawn**
- If you are offered 2nd to 6th preference school your child's name will appear on the **waiting lists** of those schools ranked at a higher preference on the application; any schools ranked at a lower preference will automatically be **withdrawn**.
