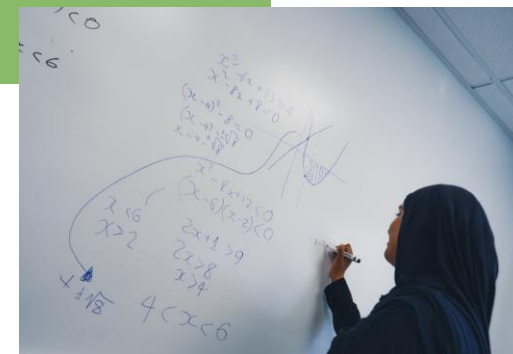
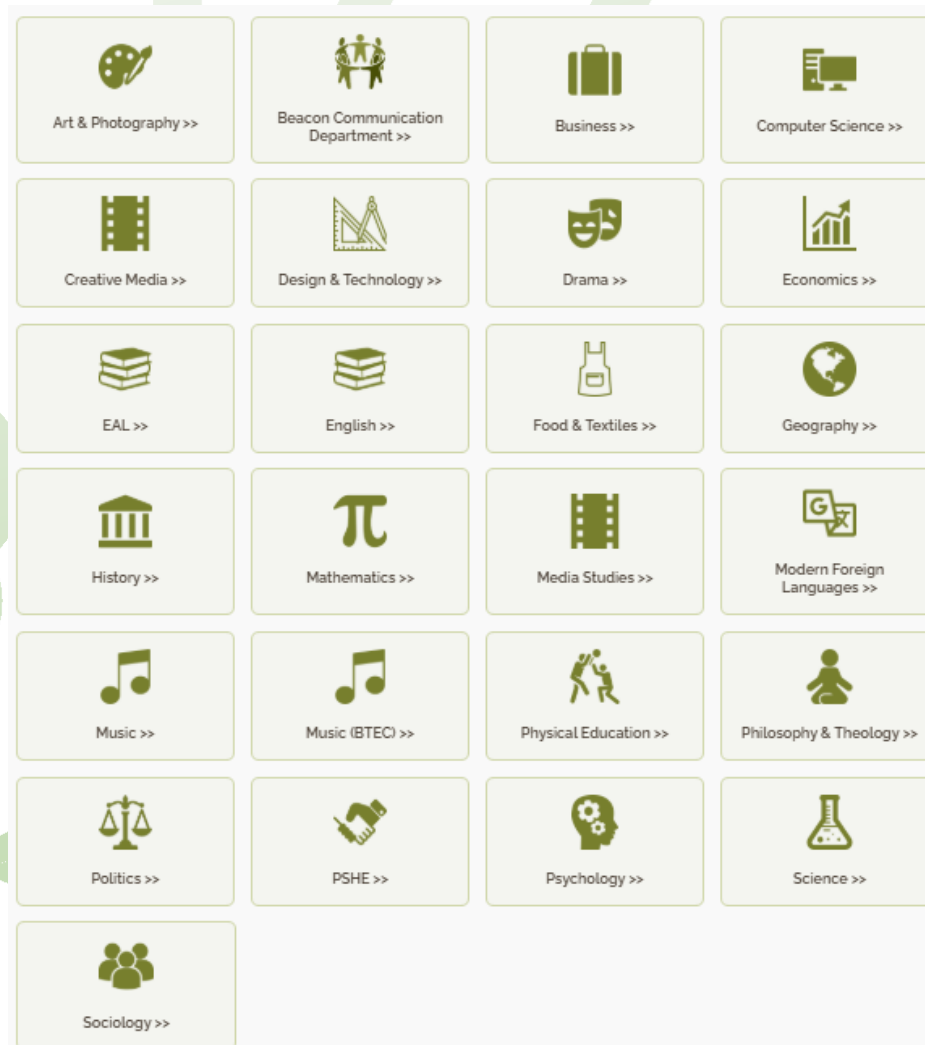

- Asked to put the school you want to go to first
- Catchment not changed
- Admissions policy and information on school website

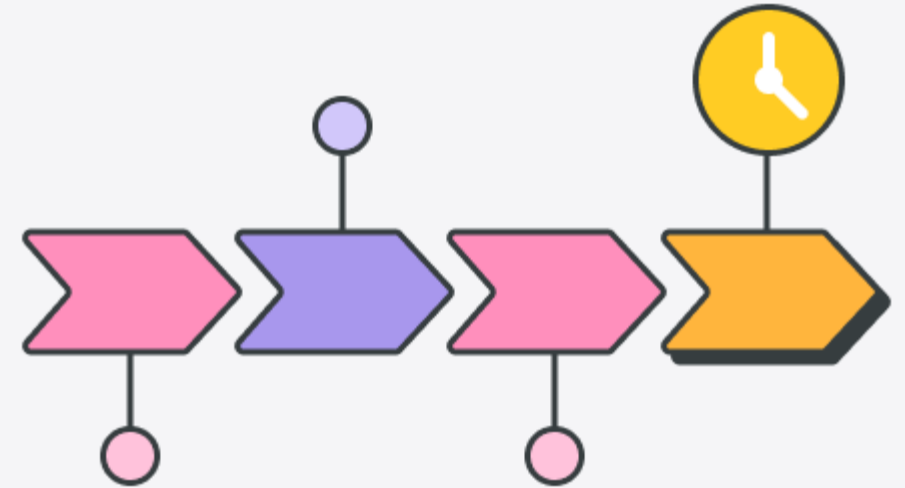

Timeline



- Application process opened on **Monday 1st September 2025** for children whose birthday falls between **1st September 2014 and 31st August 2015**
- You must apply through the Redbridge **eAdmissions portal** and attach **necessary documentation**
- The application process **closes before Midnight, at 23:59 on Friday 31st October 2026**
- Parents will be notified of the outcome on **Monday 2nd March 2026**
- The deadline for parents to **accept the offer** of a place is **15th March 2026**. Log into your eAdmissions account to do this
- LBR have a published **appeals** process
- If you are offered your **FIRST** preference school, the lower preference schools are **automatically withdrawn**
- If you are offered 2nd to 6th preference school – your child's name will appear on the **waiting lists** of those schools ranked at a higher preference on the application; any schools ranked at a lower preference will automatically be **withdrawn**.
