Important all students please note

ID badges must be worn around the neck with the lanyard and ID badge visible at all times.

- No prominent logos to be worn.
- No jewellery to be worn at any time during sporting activities.
- Mid/long hair must be tied back during all sporting activities.
- No false nails or eyelashes allowed in school at all.
- No caps or hats to be worn.
- No face coverings/ items that obscure the face are allowed.
- No leggings.

Valuables

Do not bring any valuables to school. The school cannot be held responsible for any valuable items, i.e. mobile phones, bikes, personal items etc., going missing. If you do have valuables on you at PE times these will be locked in the changing rooms. No mobile phones are allowed during PE lessons so it is advisable to leave these at home on PE days.
